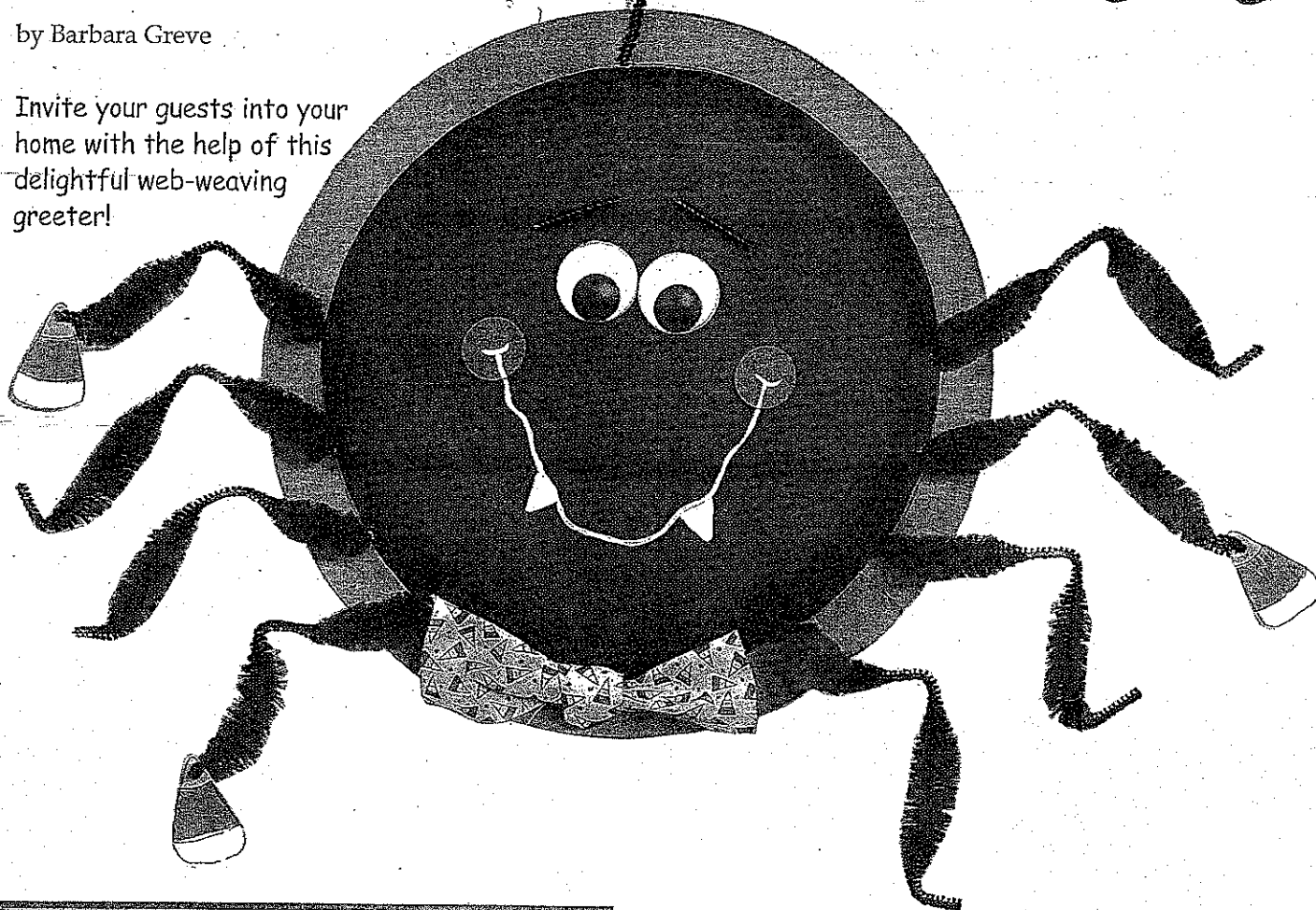


Happy Spider Wall-Hanging

Invite your guests into your home with the help of this delightful web-weaving greeter!



What You Need

- * 9" paper plate
- * Black chenille stems, two 4mm, eight bumpy
- * Acrylic paints: Titanium White, Pumpkin, Blush Flesh, Cadmium Yellow, Lamp Black
- * Flat wooden shapes: three large candy corn, two medium circles
- * Two 25mm wiggle eyes
- * 1-3/4" x 8" strip of Halloween fabric
- * Hand drill
- * Black fine-line marker
- * Thick craft glue
- * Pencil, scissors, ruler, 1/8" hole punch, paintbrush, paper plate (for palette), paper towels, eight spring clothespins
- * Americana® Acrylic Paints by DecoArt™, Woodsies® by Forster®, Kid's Choice!™ Glue by Beacon Adhesives™ Co., Inc. were used for this project.

How To Do It

1 Paint the items. (Note: Allow paint to dry between coats and color changes.) For front of spider, turn plate over so wrong side is facing up. See photo. For face, use Lamp Black to paint center raised area.  **Figure 1** Paint rim Pumpkin. For cheeks, use Blush Flesh to paint circles. See Figure 1. Drill hole in center top of each candy corn; use pencil to draw lines as indicated. Paint top of candy corns Cadmium Yellow, middle section Pumpkin, and bottoms Titanium White. Use marker to outline edges and each section of candy corns.

2 Assemble the face. See photo. Glue eyes side-by-side to face and cheeks to each side. For eyebrows, cut two 1" lengths from one 4mm chenille stem. Glue eyebrows above eyes. Use Titanium White to paint mouth and fangs as shown.
