

The Peanut Jar

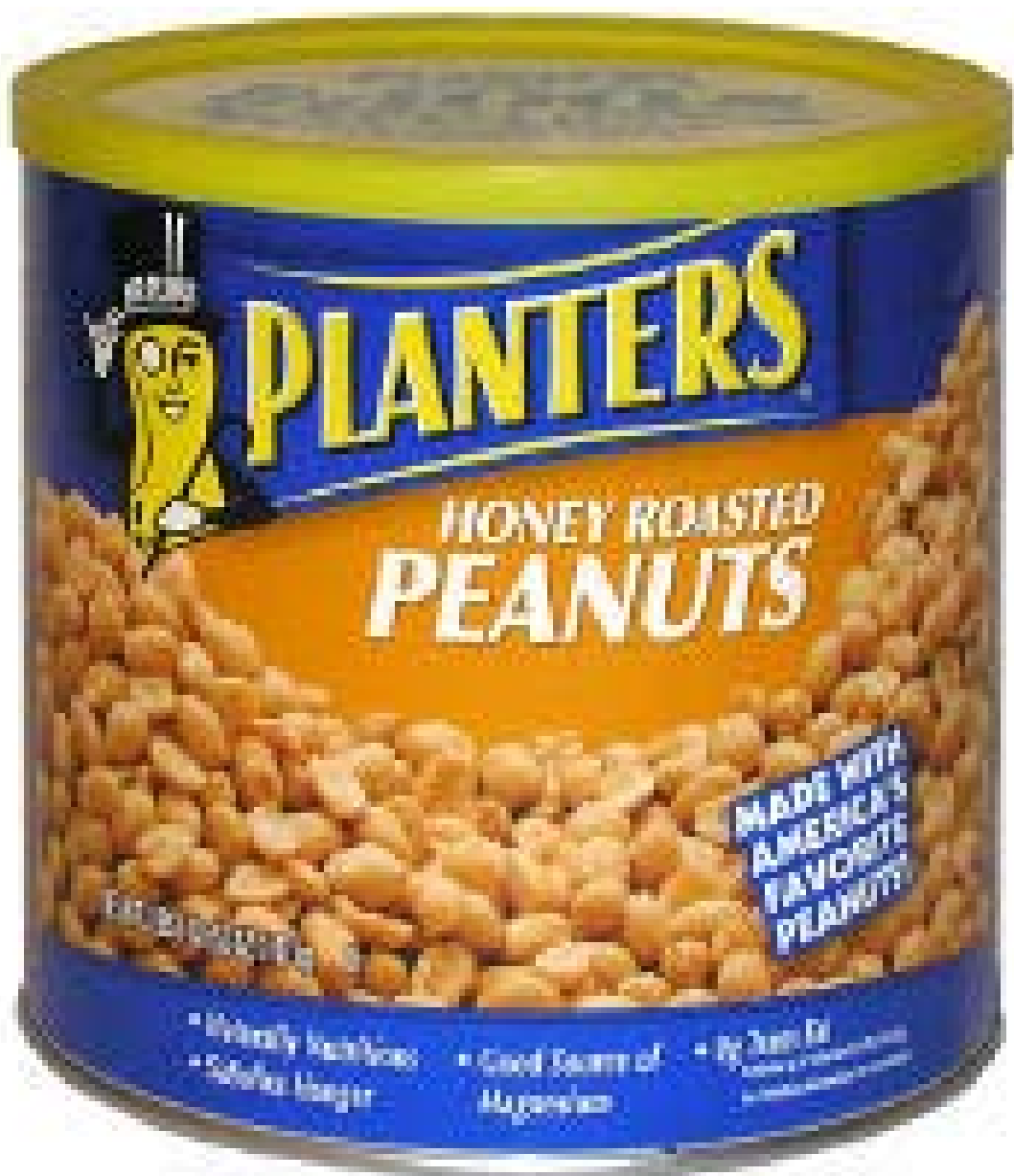
Pull a peanut out of the peanut can.
